SIX-STORY FREE-FALL SLIDES FOR SUMMER 2020 SEASON**

Opening early next summer, Bombs Away will take brave riders to a towering height of more than six-stories. Once they reach the top, riders can choose one of two ride experiences, either an enclosed, looping slide or an open vertical drop slide. From there, they enjoy a breathtaking view of the Park before stepping into an enclosed, launch capsule where the countdown begins for what will happen next. Within seconds, the floor below drops out, sending riders free falling at 26 feet per second through a heart-pounding adventure before reaching the runout below! Bombs Away also promises to be as thrilling to watch as it is to experience, allowing spectators to view riders taking the plunge through its vibrant, translucent red, white and blue layout.
